



“Manna Revelation” part 1 Sun Nov 1, 2020

I. **Exodus 16:11-21, vs. 31, 35**

A. “Give us this day our DAILY Bread...”

1. A powerful truth that has so easily been forgotten
2. Jehovah Jireh – The Lord that sees all my needs and provides my everything!
He is the God of More Than Enough!

B. Manna – God’s Supernatural Provision when we trust Him Today

1. God doesn’t want you to fret or struggle about anything
2. **Matthew 6:31-33** “Take not thought, saying....Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness...”
3. If the children of Israel can live for 40 years seeing God’s supernatural provision, supernatural protection, supernatural longevity of their clothes and shoes....why is it that so many Christians still walk in fear and unbelief?

- **The answer to the above question: Many know the Word but do not have the revelation of it! – Matthew 4:4 “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word (Rhema) that proceeds out of the mouth of God.”**
- **This is what Manna Revelation is; this is also the difference between knowing the “Logos” Word and the “Rhema” Word**

II. **Matthew 16:13-19**

A. Revelation that you can stand upon forever

1. Notice the three things that are given when you gain revelation:
 - The Blessing
 - New Identity
 - The Keys of the Kingdom
2. Peter’s revelation brought a “Rhema Word”

Here is the difference between “Rhema” and “Logos”:

Logos is the general word of God that communicates his ability to do something or His general will on a matter (example: **Mark 4:14** “The sower sows the word (logos)” – **mentioned in 316 verses**)

Rhema is the word the Holy Spirit quickens to a specific person for specific situations (example: **Romans 10:17** “Faith comes by hearing and hearing the word (Rhema) of God.” – **mentioned in 67 verses** - Faith for something comes from the Word of God that is revealed or quickened to you personally.

B. God’s Daily Promises Come Through “Rhema” Word (Fresh Manna every day)

1. Attribute the difference between being a part of the 12 disciples and the 3
2. The difference between being called and being chosen
3. The difference between *going* to heaven and *living* heaven (**John 6:63**)
