I. **Hebrews 13:5-6**

- **What does the word “forsaken” mean? Answer: To leave behind or desert**
- **What is the purpose of knowing that Jesus never forsakes you? Answer: So you can have confident boldness in the midst of a troubled world**

| - If God is for you, nothing can stand against you! |

II. Has God Forsaken His People....Or Has God’s People Forsaken Him?

A. **James 4:6-10**

1. God hasn’t left His spot; He knows His identity
2. God doesn’t “Make” anyone do anything; He gives you the choice
3. When God’s people turn the “blind eye” on sin, it can easily appear that God isn’t around (this nation has accepted murder of innocent babies and homosexuality as a part of every-day life – do you think this could be the reason why things seem to be quiet from above?)

B. The Prodigal Son (**Luke 15:17-20**)

1. I believe it’s way past time that “we come to ourselves”
2. God’s people have been too quiet for too long and yes, Satan has been gaining some significant ground
 - Turning back to God individually....
 - Turning back to God corporately....
