### I. **Luke 5:1-11**

#### A. Why do we argue with God?

1. Think about it and be honest tonight....
2. If we really believed that God knows all the secret things in this world and He knows what we need, then why do we make excuses?

#### B. “Nevertheless, at your Word...”

1. The “Nevertheless” is another way of “sighing” before we agree with God
2. The point of this life lesson is to eliminate the “nevertheless” in life and simply say, “At Your Word, Lord!”
3. Peter’s obedience encompassed the greatest financial miracle he had ever seen

#### C. **John 2:1-5**

1. “Just Do It!” (Nike must have read the Bible when they came up with their famous slogan)
2. This was a miracle of luxury not of necessity

- ***Excuses and reasonings do nothing for the kingdom of God; this is the reason why there are so many “unanswered” prayers***

- ***Procrastination is a thorn to the measure of faith; pluck it out and be quick to obey!***

### II. **II Kings 5:9-14**

- Just like Peter, Naaman “thought” (reasoned in the flesh)
- Being led by the Spirit means 1.) hearing His voice, and 2.) obeying his voice

- **Haven’t we seen enough from God to just simply believe?**
